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## **ACADEMIC WRITING IN ENGLISH**



Recent developments in the internationalisation of education in Italy mean that many academic staff are now required to teach their subject in English as well as Italian. They also need to be able to write academic papers in English and assess the written work of their students in English. This presentation will look at how academic writing skills are tested in the IELTS exam, the various task types which reflect real university writing assignments and look at sample pieces of candidates' writing collected in the Cambridge Learner Corpus, suggesting how these skills can be improved with a range of practical classroom activities.
